How to run the Tahatū Hunt in your classroom


- ◆ Welcome to the introductory Tahatū Hunt resource for Tahatū Career Navigator. Completing all four sections will give students the knowledge they need to begin their journey with Tahatū.
- ◆ Feel free to adapt the Tahatū Hunt to suit your needs. This could mean focusing on just one or two sections, or completing all four sections within a lesson.
- ◆ The Tahatū Hunt can be completed individually or in teams.
- ◆ Students must have a laptop or another internet-connected device to search Tahatū.
- ◆ If working in teams, consider assigning roles such as searcher, writer, and idea prompter.
- ◆ Distribute the Tahatū Hunt question sheets from the pad. One sheet per student or team.
- ◆ Ask students to write their name or team name on the worksheet.
- ◆ Each section should take 5 to 10 minutes to complete.
- ◆ **Answers for all sections are on the reverse of this sheet.**
- ◆ You may choose to read the answers aloud, distribute this sheet or pre-prepare copies for your students. Students can self-mark on their question sheets.
- ◆ Each correct answer earns one point.
- ◆ If the Tahatū Hunt is completed individually, encourage students to take their worksheet home and discuss something they have learnt with their parents or whānau.
