

# Tahatū activity guide 3 School and NCEA



## Aratohu mahinga Tahatū 3 Kura

The School and NCEA Kura section on Tahatū Career Navigator introduces students to information about NCEA subjects and moving on from school.

### Activities overview

#### Tirohanga whānui ki ngā mahi

To introduce students to the learning areas and subjects on Tahatū and information about choosing NCEA subjects.

### Activity 1: 'How to choose your subjects' video

#### Mahi 1: Kōwhiringa marau ataata

### Activity overview

#### Tirohanga whānui ki te mahi

To show students the steps they can take to choose school subjects.

**Activity type:** Individually **Time taken:** 15-20 mins

#### Activity: How to choose your subjects video (Year 9-13)

##### Steps

Ask your students to watch the career tips video 'How to choose your subjects' on the 'Choosing NCEA subjects' guide page.

##### Conversation starters

- Who can you talk about your career ideas with, for example, friends, parents, whānau, teachers? (They may want to name that person or their role.)
- What are the main subjects mentioned in the video?
- Why is it important to pick subjects that you enjoy or are good at?
- When choosing your subjects what do you need to consider when thinking about your future?

##### Steps

Direct students to the School and NCEA Kura section of Tahatū.

Below are the questions your students will find in the Tahatū Hunt:

1. Go to the 'Explore NCEA subjects' page. What is the te reo Māori translation of 'Browse by learning area'?
2. Go to the geography NCEA subject page. Draw the 'Study towards' icon.
3. Go to the 'New Zealand languages Ngā reo o Aotearoa' learning area. Name the kaupapa Māori subject.
4. Go to the 'Choosing NCEA subjects' guide page and watch the 'How to choose your subjects' video. What is Step 2?
5. Go to the 'Planning for life after school' guide page and watch the 'How to answer 'that' career question' video. What is Step 1?
